



## PASSPORT

### OVERVIEW

Passport is a new initiative designed to enhance opportunities for individuals who have a developmental disability.

This initiative provides funds to individuals who have left high school and are requiring supports to increase their participation in the community.

Individuals and families have the option of purchasing their own community participation supports or accessing services from existing transfer payment agencies.

Priority is given to individuals who live at home and who have minimal funded community participation supports.

### PROCESS

Individuals with a developmental disability who have left school and are seeking funding for community participation

Individual completes a Passport Application Assistance could be provided by connected community agencies including schools or Developmental Service Agencies as well as the Passport Facilitator

Application is sent to Keystone and reviewed using a standard Ministry guide

When funding becomes available, applications are prioritized and individuals are informed of funding

Individuals and Families meet with the Passport Facilitator to discuss funding options and planning
