
We provide a multi-disciplinary therapeutic approach for youth and their families.

This live-in program assists youth with regaining self control, building trusting relationships with adults and making life-altering changes.

# Building Futures Together

The residence is a crisis assessment and stabilization program for youth.

We provide:

A safe and welcoming environment.

Respect for youth and parents.

Qualified professional staff.

24 - 7 support and supervision.

A multi-disciplinary approach that supports young people and their families experiencing significant mental health difficulties.

A specialized therapeutic and educational environment for the youth to live in for 3 to 6 weeks.

The program is licensed by the Ministry of Children & Youth Services and accredited by Children's Mental Health Ontario.

Voluntary program that requires a referral from Keystone staff with parental and youth consent.

Team approach inclusive of parents and youth with an individualized school program available.

7 unit facility is co-ed and ages range from 12 to 17.
